If you are planning on trashing the items listed below please consider leaving them in a box or bag in your kitchen instead. Please bag open liquids (cleaning items) together and place in the kitchen sink just in case of a leak.

Not only will you be helping others, you will reduce the amount of items that end up in the land fill.

## **Please be sure to only leave listed items.**

### Food we can accept:

Any un-opened canned or packaged foods, soups, meats, canned vegetables, fruits, or sauces of any type.

### Food we can't accept:

Opened foods, fresh foods, frozen foods, open boxes or loose foods.

### ZipLock style plastic bags:

Open boxes are fine but the bags should be unused.

### School Supplies do not need to be new but should have much of their life left to them:

Pencils, pens, erasers, high lighters, markers, crayons, chalk, notebooks, binders, scissors, glue, rubber cement, staplers, tape, rulers, calculators, paper and back packs. Any other items school kids could use.

### Books for general use (not course specific textbooks)

Dictionaries, Thesaurus, Atlas, Reference books, children's books

### Toiletries: (Unopened Only)

Unused razors or replacement blades, unopened bar soap, unopened tooth paste, unopened deodorant, unopened tooth brushes, unopened combs or brushes.

### Toiletries: (New or Opened)

Shaving cream, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, liquid soap, toilet paper.

### Cleaning items: (New or Opened)

Any cleaning chemicals, new SOS pads, new sponges, glass cleaners, bleach, toilet bowl cleaners, hand dish washing soap, automatic dish washing soap, laundry soap, fabric softener, softener sheets, paper towels, or rags.

### Clothing:

Any clothing that is in decent shape, any size. Pants, shirts, skirts, dresses, blouses, shorts, sweatshirts, jackets, coats, sweaters or pairs of shoes are all great. Please no underwear, bras, socks or stockings.

Clothing does not need to be washed, folded or on a hanger. The distributing agencies will do this before it reaches the end user.

### Media, Games and Players:

DVD, CD's, board games (with all pieces), non-violent video games, radio or stereo, MP3 player.

### Kitchen items:

Please be sure that kitchen items are free of food or grease. Any plates, glasses, cups, mugs, bowls, dishes, bake ware, pots, pans, flatware, utensils, small appliances (coffee maker, can opener, toaster, rice cooker). Items do not need to be in full sets or match in any way.

### Towels and Bedding:

Towels, sheets, pillow cases, blankets, comforters all free of large tears or heavy stains.

### Local Gift Cards, Gift certificates and loose change:

Each year we see lots of these items swept into the trash. Let someone else make use of these things.

### Furniture and Beds:

We are unable to collect and distribute furniture and bedding.
